Book Club

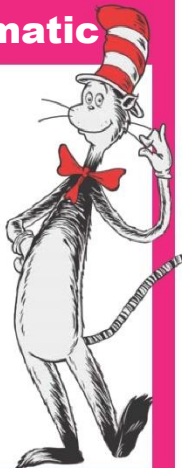
So many books, and not enough time to read them all, but here are the main ones that we will be reading.
